*Members' rate applies to Regular, Associate, Accredited Regional Federation and Developer Members of CWCF. **Conference registration fees cover supper on Thursday, lunch and supper on Friday, and lunch on Saturday. Taxes and gratuities included. Breakfast is included with the accommodation rates. For those staying off-site, breakfast is an additional \$10.00/day. Lunch will be one one's own at the Skydragon Co-op. ***. *If your organization does not fit into any of the member categories and the non-member rate is out of reach, please talk to us!* Further, a few subsidies for registration (full or partial) will be available, on an exceptional basis; please speak to us to explore this possibility as well. We do not want people staying away due to the fees.

ACCOMMODATIONS AT THE CENTRE:

*****IMPORTANT:** Please do not contact the Centre, but rather contact the CWCF directly. To offer these rates to groups, the Centre only block-books rooms; it does not handle individual room requests. Thank you.***

Accommodations will be at the Canterbury Hills Centre in Ancaster. All rooms are shared, either 2, 3 or 4 people to a room with shared washrooms. [For hotels nearby, see

below.] The Centre's accommodations are available in three varieties: (1) rooms at Bagnall Lodge, comfortable retreat centre-style rooms at \$55/night; (2) rooms at Artaban Lodge, upgraded camping cabins with bunk beds, at \$45/person/night; and (3) simple log cabins, with bunk beds where guests must supply their own linens (towels, sleeping bag or equivalent, pillow), at \$20/night. If you want to stay over on Saturday night, this is possible. However, it will require moving to a different lodge on-site. The rate will be higher, the room will likely be a single room and it will not include breakfast. If you prefer to billet with a local resident, we *may* be able to arrange this. The rates on-site are as follows:

Rooms will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Your first choice may not be available. However, please make your room reservations through CWCF as we have block-booked all rooms.

OTHER ACCOMMODATIONS: There are two hotels within a 15-minute drive of the Centre: Admiral Inn (www.admiralinn.com/; choose the one in Hamilton), and Visitors Inn (www.visitorsinn.com/). If you want to stay off-site, you will need to make your own arrangements.

TRAVEL GENERALLY : We encourage you to book flights with the Canadian Travel Co-op / Carlson Wagonlit (1-800-263-5241), or Drum Travel Co-op (1-416-964-3388), both worker co-ops. *Please let them know you are attending the CWCF Conference.* Some individuals from Toronto, Ottawa & other nearby regions will be car-pooling to the Conference; please indicate on the registration form if you are interested in joining or starting a car-pool.

Air Transportation: Ancaster is served primarily by the Hamilton Airport (20 minutes away), but many people will find more convenient flights through the Toronto Pearson Airport (50 + minutes away), & we will arrange car-pools & taxi pools from both.

Ground Transportation from the Airport: Taxi fare from the Hamilton airport to the Centre is approximately \$25. Taxi fare from Pearson is high although we do not have an estimate. For a cheaper option, you can take the Airways Transit, 905-527-7511 / www.airwaystransit.com, from either airport; they need 2 day's advance notice. Again, we will also try to arrange carpooling or taxi-pooling upon request.

TRANSPORTATION SUBSIDY

A transportation subsidy is available to active worker co-op members who choose to fly (and who come from outside of a 1/2-day driving time/radius into Ancaster) to assist them to attend. This amount will be approximately 1/2 the seatsale airfare cost. If you require this subsidy, please indicate this on your registration form. Remember that large savings can be realized by booking your flight early. Please book early, as the individual

subsidy, and possibly the number of subsidies, will be limited. CWCF will also subsidize the cost of car-pooling from outside the greater Toronto / Hamilton / Guelph region.
